- Anyone can refer a potential patient to the Program. - All patients accepted into the Program must obtain a physician's prescription for therapy before services can be started, before obtaining a prescription, please call us to find out about available services in your area.
- 3. Each therapist prioritizes his/her caseload based on need. Priority is given to: Families with transportation difficulties, those children who, without services, will experience deterioration in their status, patients with financial need for free services (this often includes middle class families whose insurance does not pay). We ask that you use up available insurance.
- 4. Children who qualify for services can include children receiving school-based services whose insurance will not pay for private therapy, home schooled children, children in government programs where no other therapist is available, children who do not qualify for Part C services but, may exhibit some delays needing therapy, children transitioning from part C who do not qualify for school-based services or who may be transitioning at the end of a school year, families with more than one child finding it difficult to get to services, families with transportation difficulties. Medical, educational and developmental services are available.
- 5. All therapy is offered by the Florida Elks Children's Therapy Services (FECTS) free of charge to the families as part of the Elks' charitable works. Insurance and government programs are not charged.
- 6. Parent/guardian or their designated responsible adult over 18 must be present at each session.
